GENT, Jan De

Haarlem 18.III.1742–8.X.1830

A member of the Haarlem guild of painters from 1776, he may have been associated with Jelgersma: pseudopendant pastels of his father and mother were apparently made by the two artists. He married Anna van den Bos (1738–1802).
