GIANNINI, Vincenzo

fl. Florence 1776-1807

During his stay in Florence, John Ramsay, son of the painter Allan Ramsay, kept a diary; on 8.XI.1783 he breakfasted with Hugh Douglas Hamilton and Francesco Gianfigliazzi. They then visited three Florentine artists: Giuseppe Fabbrini, who had a collection of engravings of statues, Pascinio (untraced), who had a portrait of Lord Cowper, and "Giannini, another famous painter" who "showd us Lady Cowper in Pastelli." Elsewhere Ramsay refers to pastels as crayons; Hamilton made several pastels of the countess. The name is mistranscribed as Giovanni in Ingamells 2003, but the manuscript (National Library of Scotland) is clear. Ramsay started lessons with Giannini soon after this entry, dispelling any doubt.

The inventories of the Cowper collection published by Ellis 2005 include references to four pastels by Giannini, of the Countess's husband and three sons, although that of the Countess herself is not listed.

According to the archives of the Accademia delle arti del disegno in Florence, Vincenzo Giannini was a painter and miniaturist, elected professore at the Accademia 12.I.1787. He was known as a copyist in the Regia Galleria from as early as 1776, and was charged with dispatching Sir Horace Mann's picture collection to England.

He is represented in the Palazzo Pitti (oil of Maria Theresia Königin von Sachsen); he is possibly the "Giannini", an Italian miniaturist recorded in Bénézit for a miniature of Christoph von Buckwaldt c.1820.
