GODDARD, Thomas

London 11.XII.1738 – Oxford 1805
"Mr Goddard" who advertised in the Oxford journal, 14.IV.1792 and 16.IV.1796, as a portrait painter and drawing master, with his Academy at Mr Joyce's, opposite the University and City Bank in the High Street, where he "continues to take Likenesses in Miniature and Crayons." He also restored paintings. Identified in the NPG database as Thomas Goddard, active in London, exhibiting at the Royal Academy 1778–88 before moving to Oxford. He was probably the son of Thomas and Martha Goddard born 11.XII.1738.
