GRIMM, Johann

Bern 1677–1747

Some sources suggest that he was born in Berthoud in 1675. Swiss miniaturist, portrait and landscape painter. He was a pupil of Joseph Werner, whose art collection he acquired. He established a drawing school at Bern and taught Johann Ludwig Aberli (*q.v.*). His nephew Samuel Hieronymus Grimm of Burgdorf was a prolific painter and draughtsman.
