GUÉRIN, Jean-Urbain

Strasbourg 1.IV.1761 – Obernai 29.X.1836 Pupil of the pastellist Huin (*q.v.*). According to Lehmann, Guérin's first works were in pastel, and were noticed by the gouverneur of Alsace, the maréchal de Contades, under whose protection he was sent to Paris quite young. Pastel painting being already out of fashion, he turned to the miniature and joined Augustin's studio.
