HAINZELMANN, Johann

Augsburg 1641 – Berlin 1693 Brother of Elias; both were pupils of François de Poilly in Paris, and specialised in reproductive portrait engraving. Johann moved to Berlin where became court engraver. Apart from portraits, he engraved religious subjects after Annibale Carracci, Sebastiano Bordone etc. According to de Boni, a number of his portrait engravings were made after his own pastels.
