HENDRIKS, Wybrand

Amsterdam 24.VI.1744 – Haarlem 28.I.1831

Painter (of landscapes, still lifes and portraits) and collector; curator of the Teylers Foundation, the earliest public Dutch art museum. He was trained in Amsterdam and was active also in Haarlem (1775; 1786–1831); he visited England and Belgium in 1775.
