HESS, Ludwig

Zurich 18.x.1760–13.IV.1800

Swiss landscape painter and engraver. He initially followed his father's trade as a butcher, but was persuaded to take up art professionally by Salomon Gessner. He visited Florence and Rome in 1794. He commenced engraving only two years before his death. Chodowiecki mentions a "Pastellmaler Heß" in a letter to Gräfin Christiane von Solms-Laubach (20.IV.1784); his editor suggests that this may be Ludwig Hess.
