HIEN, J. van

fl. The Netherlands 1771–75

Records of J. van Hien and of J. W. Hien (*q.v.*) have been confused. It seems safe however to conclude, on the basis of the signature, style and difference in quality, that the Hoorn pastels and a few others in private collections are by the author of a number of fairly limited portraits in oil, and have nothing to do with the author of the earlier pastels. J. van Hien's heads are particularly characteristic of the Dutch domestic tradition going back to P. F. de La Croix (*q.v.*).
