### HORNEMAN, Christian

Copenhagen 1765–1844

Also Hornemann. Trained in the Copenhagen academy from 1782, he won silver medals in 1785 and 1786. In 1787 he embarked on sixteen years of travel, to France, Germany, Austria and Italy, falling under the influence of J. H. W. Tischbein, Füger and Chodowiecki (*qq.v.*). He returned to his native city to become a member of the Kunstakademi in 1805. His enthusiasm for music led to portraits of Haydn, Beethoven, Carl Maria von Weber, Kuhlau and members of the Gerson family. He was principally a miniaturist, but also did some pastels. Those we have found all seem to belong to well into the nineteenth century, and are not catalogued in full here. There are some later copies, notably by Hans Christian Vantore.
