Master Horsley exhibited a head “in chalks” at the Free Society in 1774 (from James Street, Covent Garden), probably at a younger age than the J. or Thomas Worsley who entered the RA Schools four years later, aged 24. Waterhouse copies Graves in calling him a crayon painter, but there is nothing to support this.
