Very little is known of the life of this Irish portrait painter, said to have been born in Ulster and known to have been active in Dublin from 1752 to 1783. A pastel recorded as signed is evidently a confusion with Hurter (q.r.). Hunter's full-length portrait of George, Earl Temple, soon to be 1st Marquess of Buckingham, was copied in pastel by Philip Adams (q.r.).
