HACKERT, Karl Ludwig

Prenzlau 1740 – Morges 1796

Landscape and genre painter; brother of the better known Jakob Philipp Hackert (1737–1807), a painter, draughtsman and gouachiste known for his Italian landscapes. The Toulouse catalogue identifies the artist as Carle Hackert, and specifies that “ces deux tableau sont au pastel, & sans prétention.” The pictures are not now catalogued, and it is unclear whether they were correctly described.
