HAGELGANS, Michael Christoph Emanuel

Darmstadt 26.III.1725–25.IX.1766

Hagelgans was a pupil of the Hofmaler J. Chr. Fiedler (*q.v.*) in Darmstadt. From 1755 he worked in Vienna, where he was appointed Hofmaler to Karl Alexander von Lothringen and is known to have made oil copies after Meytens. He is credited with five pastels of the ruling family executed around 1761 for the pastel cabinet in the Neues Schloß, Bayreuth (created by Wilhelmine Markgräfin von Bayreuth but evidently continued by her successor Sofie Karoline). He was back in Vienna in 1762, and was subsequently recorded in Berlin, Gotha, and Darmstadt, where he was Hofmaler. He married the daughter of a Bayreuth painter who worked as a pastellist; after his death, she remarried, but soon divorced, and continued to use Hagelegans's name (*q.v.*).
