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HARPER, Johann Stockholm 1688 – Potsdam 1746 Swedish miniaturist, in Berlin from 1712. A pupil of Martin Meytens and Daniel Kraft, his style is close to Pesne's but rather stiffer. A pastel was exhibited in 1786. His son Adolf Friedrich Harper (1725–1806) was a landscape painter and pupil of Richard Wilson.
