HAZLITT, John

Marshfield 13.v.1767 – Stockport 16.v.1837

Brother of the essayist, he was a portraitist in oil and miniature. The family was based in America between 1783 and 1787. In 1785 John set up an art school with Joseph Dunkerley in Boston. After his return to London he exhibited numerous portraits and miniatures at the Royal Academy between 1788 and 1819, from various addresses in Soho.
