## HEEMS, Louis-François-Joseph

Lille 1730–1.11.1811 The Lille pastellist, whose date of birth is provided on the inscription, can be identified from his burial certificate (Lille, Nord, 1.II.1811) which records him as a native of Lille, 81 years of age. He may be the pupil at the Académie royale who won prizes in 1755, although the accomplishment does not seem sufficient. Louis-François-Joseph Heems, peintre en émail is also known from the 1766 posthumous inventory of his wife Marie-Louise Moulin (and named in the registres de tutelles in 1790); they lived in Paris, quai des Morfondues. In 1780 in Paris he married his second wife, Marie-Jeanne Le Bouteiller de La Varenne, from whom he was divorced.
