

**HEMET, Marie-Anne-
Bonaventure, Mme François-Noël
Lespinasse de Saune**

Auch 1764 – Toulouse 18.v.1838

In 1784 the name was misspelled phonetically as Emet, the entries here conflated in 2021. Mlle Hemet, who exhibited again the following year, was a pupil of Sabère and Roques; no doubt amateur. She was surely Marie-Anne-Bonaventure Hemet or Hémet, born in 1764 to Nicolas-Louis Hémet, a farmer in Auch, and his wife, Jeanne-Marie Dulong, and died at 16 rue de la Dalbade, Toulouse 18.v.1838, the widow of François-Noël Lespinasse de Saune whom she married at Saint-Pierre de Toulouse, 12.II.1796. He owned the château de Pessan (Gers); the family's wealth derived from the trade in woad. A son, Noël-Marie-Barthélémy-Adrien, was born in 1807. Her brother Jean-Baptiste was a négociant in Toulouse. Among homonyms, a Blaise-Adrien Hemet, négociant à Toulouse, was a representative on the Conseil général de la Haute-Garonne from 1815. A sieur Hémet was the Vénérable de la Loge auscitaine in 1762.
