IMBERT DES MOTELETTES, Henri-Albert

Bruges 23.XI.1764–27.II.1837

Pupil of Garemijn. He entered Capucin monastery in France but following the suppression of the order under the Revolution he returned to Bruges and married. Between 1801 and 1811 he was a judge but continued to paint in his spare time. He was chiefly a landscape painter; he also made copies of old masters and life drawings in pastel.
