LA CROIX, Susanne de

Amsterdam 31.XII.1755 – The Hague .V.1789 Daughter of Pieter Frederik de La Croix (*q.v.*), born in Amsterdam and baptised there (as Susanne, not Susanna as often appears) four days later, on 3.I.1756. On 17.ix.1775 in The Hague she married the still life painter and poet Jan van Os (1744–1808). The suggestion that she was also deaf-mute appears to be a confusion between early sources. The only surviving pastel given to her bears a date four years after her death from smallpox, and is surely a misattribution of a work by her brother, Isaac de La Croix (*q.v.*).
