LANGLOIS, Jérôme

Paris 1753–15.I.1837

Miniaturist. The son of a marchand mercier and marchand de fer, Claude-Barthélemy Langlois, and Anne Lochet, he enrolled with Vien at the Académie from 1770 to 1776. He was third medallist at the Académie royale in 1780, and exhibited in the salons from 1793. The only known pastel (or coloured chalk drawing) is of his friend Buzot. He also made miniatures of Buzot and his friend, Mme Roland. According to the Fonds Andriveau he married Elisabeth-François Goudrez on 25.VII.1780 at the church of Cardinal Lemoine, île de la Cité. Langlois's son Jérôme-Martin (1779–1838) was also a portraitist.
