Portrait and history painter; *agréé* 1663; *reçu* 1663.
A misprint in Meyer 2017, p. 458 suggests that he was the author of the Nanteuil pastel of Philippe d'Orléans at Chaalis which in fact is by Nanteuil and relates to the print on the next page in Meyer. It is most unlikely that he was the author of the pastel in the Walferdin sale.
