## LE GUÉ, Jean Constantin

The Hague 26.VI.1738 – Rotterdam 13.III.1823  
Probably related, and possibly confused, with H. Le Gué (*q.v.*). “J. C. Le Gué” is here (2024) identified as the Jean Constantine or Johan Constantijn Le Gue recorded in Rotterdam in 1773 (at the baptism of a son by his wife, Pieterrella Marija Niewenhuizen) and in Arnhem 1777 and 1780 (two more children). On 28.VII.1790 in Rotterdam he was remarried, to Marie-Victoire Chupot du Rosier; at least ten children were born in the following 20 years. His death certificate gives his exact age to the day and place of birth.
