

# Neil Jeffares, *Dictionary of pastellists before 1800*

### LEPRINCE, Jean-Baptiste

Metz 1734 – Saint-Denis-du-Port 1781

Landscape painter; trained in Paris in Boucher's studio from 1750, before spending five years in St Petersburg from 1756. He was *agrégé* 1764, *reçu* 1765, exhibiting Russian themed genre pictures. Leprince experimented with new processes of engraving. Like his teachers Vien and Boucher, Leprince used pastel for sketches of women's heads as well as for some landscapes. The results appear to use the medium graphically, but few examples have survived. There are however numerous records from contemporary sales, including an unusual number of pastels described as "d'après le Prince". Jean-Baptiste Huët (*q.n.*) was a pupil.
