LISIEWSKA, Julie, Frau Wildfang

Dessau 1767–1837

The basis of the attribution of the pastel of Beatrice Cenci is uncertain; the painting traditionally given to Guido Reni (but now thought to be by Elisabetta Sirani) was widely copied in oil and pastel (*v.g.* Sofia Giordano). If it is by Julie Lisiewska, the artist was the daughter of Christoph Fr. R. Lisiewski; she married a Herr Wildfang. A couple of pastels are recorded. Her sister Friederike Juliane Lisiewska (1769–1856) portrayed her in oil. Bénézit confuses matters by inventing a Julie Lisiewska, another sister of Rosina and Dorothea, giving her the years of birth and death of another sister, Christiana Sophie (1723–) and her brother Christoph (1725–1794).
