**Frederike LOUISE Wilhelmine von
Braunschweig-Wolfenbüttel, née
van Oranje-Nassau**

The Hague 1770–1819

Prinses Frederike Louise Wilhelmina van Oranje-Nassau followed in her grandmother's footsteps as an amateur pastellist. In 1790 she married Karl Georg August von Braunschweig-Wolfenbüttel, heir to Karl II. Wilhelm who outlived him.
