1762–p.1780

Pupil of William Burgess (*q.v.*); he exhibited pictures, including a fancy head “in chalks” at the Free Society in 1772 (aged 10) and in 1780. Waterhouse copies Graves in calling him a crayon painter, but there is nothing to support this.
