LENOIR, César

fl. France 1801

Untraced; the name possibly Cezarine, but Cezarius as reported is possibly a latinised form of César. The signature is not an exact match but close enough to suggest this may be the 18-year old César Lenoir, a marchand de vin in Fourmies (Nord) where he was born 1.III.1783, the son of Nicolas and Marie-Anne Leclerc; he was married twice, to Marie-Marguerite-Joseph Daniel and in 1830 to Aimée-Victoire-Esthère Flament; he died in Fourmies, 2.VIII.1849.
