

LEVITSKY, Dmitry Grigorievich

Kiev .v.1735 – St Petersburg 17.IV.1822

Дмитрий Григорьевич Левитский; Russian portraitist. Although usually known only for oils, the pastel in Rome now attributed to him seems to show strong similarities with the characteristic handling of drapery displayed in works such as the portrait of Princess Praskovia Repnina (GRM).
