LUCATELLI, Giuseppe

Mogliano 16.III.1751 – Tolentino 1828

Also Locatelli; painter, occasional portraitist and architect. He studied in Rome with Mengs and Conca, and returned to Tolentino where he decorated the Vaccaj theatre. It is unclear if he made any pastels before 1800, and unclear if he is the “G. Locatelli” identified in the 1913 catalogue. A group of 26 pastels copied after the Correggio frescoes in the Cupola di San Giovanni di Parma were attributed to him in an 1897 inventory by the then owner.
