LUSURIER, Catherine

Paris 1752–11.I.1781

Painter, closely connected with the Drouais family (*q.v.*); the daughter of a hatter and a couturière, she was the niece of Hubert Drouais's wife. Her funeral was announced in the *Journal de Paris*, 12.I.1781: "Catherine Luzurier, fille majeure, peintresse, rue des Orties, butte Saint-Roch." Ashmore (2001) has reconstituted a significant body of oil portraits, but the attribution of a handful of pastels to her, of which only one is known from a poor photograph, should be regarded with caution.
