MAGGI, Contessa, née Ortensia Poncarali

Brescia 1732-1811

Daughter of Ercole Poncarli (or Poncarale), and Chiara Rodengo, she married conte Annibale Camillo Maggi-Via in 1762, and lived for a long time in Parma. She was taught to paint by Francesco Monti. The pastel in Parma is her morceau de réception at the Accademia di Belle Arte (1760), her only surviving work. The following year she was admitted to the Accademia di Bologna. Two other portraits by her were in the Barbisoni collection in 1760, medium unspecified (she worked in oil as well as pastel).
