MARIE-ANTOINETTE, reine de France, née von Österreich

Vienna 1755 – Paris 1793

Maria Antonia Josepha Johanna Erzherzogin von Österreich, the future queen of France, was taught to draw by Mme Beyer-Bertrand (*q.v.*) along with several of her sisters (*v.q.* Maria Christine). A number of drawings in sanguine, gouache or pastel are preserved in the Schönbrunn palace. One is a copy of a painting (now in a Canadian private collection) by Jan Miense Molenaer (1661).
