MEDINA, John III

Edinburgh 1721–1796

Portrait painter, grandson of the Flemish painter Sir John Baptist de Medina who settled in Edinburgh c.1693. His son and grandson wre also portrait painters. John III, who exhibited oils at the Society of Artists 1772–74 (not the Royal Academy), advertised his trade from World's End Close, Netherbow in the *Caledonian Mercury*, 21.VII.1792, offering also to teach drawing in all its branches, either in oil, crayons, indian ink, or water colours. He also cleaned and repaired paintings (among them some in Holyrood Palace) and made copies...
