MEISSONIER, Juste-Aurèle

Turin 17.III.1695 – Paris 31.VII.1750

Painter, sculptor, architect and goldsmith. Of French extraction, he was born in Italy but moved to Paris in 1718, where he was appointed orfèvre du roi in 1724. Two years later he was made dessinateur de la chambre et du cabinet du roi. He left a large number of drawn designs, some of which were described as in pastel.
