NASINI, Apollonio

Florence 17.VIII.1692 – Siena 18.IV.1786

Son and pupil of Giuseppe Nicola Nasini (*q.v.*), active in Florence and Siena; his pastel style is said to be highly competent and indistinguishable from his father's.
