Venice 1724 – ?

Daughter of Bartolomeo Nazari (*q.v.*). She commenced her career copying her father's work in both oil and pastel. She produced religious pictures as well as portraits, and was commissioned by the Venetian noble Paolo Donado to make a collection of portraits of the sovereigns of Europe.
