### **PAILLOT, Dominique**

Dijon 4.IV.1774 – Besançon 13.VI.1814

The son of a musicien from the Sainte-Chapelle, he was a pupil of Devosge; he worked only in miniature, charcoal and pastel. In 1794, in Dijon, he married a Philiberte-Camille Bolley. In 1807 he was appointed professeur at the reorganised École de dessin in Besançon alongside the much older but less talented Jourdain (*q.v.*). It is likely that the pastels recorded at Besançon were executed after that date. A lengthy eulogy in verse, by M. Viancin, appeared in the proceedings of the Académie de Besançon in 1841.
