PARADIS, Louis

Toul 12.IV.1760–p.1816

The attribution is given in the article by Gérard Howald, and is no doubt to a local artist. He is probably the “Louis Paradis, Peintre de l’Académie royale” recorded, with his wife, Françoise-Marie-Rose Tissot, at the marriage of their daughter Jeanne-Lucie-Barbe-Louise (1791–) to François Drouard in Toul, 18.III.1816. His own marriage was held 3.II.1789 at Saint-Amand, Toul, where he had been baptised 29 (not 27 as stated in the marriage entry) years before; he was there described as an académicien de Lille en Flandres.
