PARAZA, Mme de Jouglà de, née Marie-Sophie de Bonfontan

Lyon 1768 – Toulouse 15.VIII.1800

Also Parasa; a pupil of M. Sabère-Bastide, adjoint à professeur, Académie de Toulouse. She was the daughter of the comte de Lastours, premier Capitoul de Toulouse, and in 1789, in Toulouse, she married Henri-Élisabeth de Jouglà, baron de Paraza (1745–1800), président à mortier in the parlement de Toulouse, 23 years her senior. It was nevertheless, it is said, a love match. There were six children. Marie-Sophie died at 33 rue Boulbonne, Toulouse, eight months after the birth of the youngest, just a few weeks after her husband.
