Genoa 1705 – Lisbon 1785

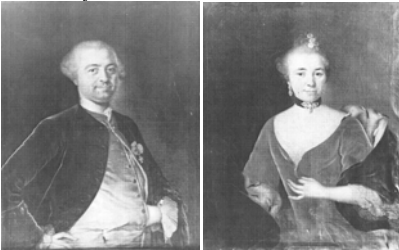
Pellegrino Parodi was the son of the Genoese painter Domenico Parodi (1672–1742). He appears to have worked in Genoa before travelling to Lisbon, where he is found in 1759 and seems to have spent the remainder of his career.
