## **PFEIFFER, Franz Josef**

Aachen 1741 – Bruxelles 1807

Also François-Joseph; portraitist and engraver; worked in Amsterdam and Bruxelles. Presumably the father of the stage designer and watercolourist François-Joseph II Pfeiffer (1778–1835).
