### PFEIFFER, Franz Josef

Aachen 1741 – Bruxelles 1807

Also François-Joseph; portraitist and engraver; worked in Amsterdam and Bruxelles. In 1781 he exhibited three pastels at the Société d'Émulation de Liège, his address given as "demeurant Hors-Château". He was the father of the stage designer and watercolourist François-Joseph II Pfeiffer (1778–1835).
