**PONIATOWSKI, comtesse, née
Maria Teresa Kinsky von Wchinitz
und Tettau**

Vienna 1740–1806

La comtesse Poniatowski paid 190 florins for lessons with Pierre-Joseph Lion (*q.v.*) during his stay in Vienna 1760–68. She was evidently Maria Teresa Kinsky von Wchinitz und Tettau (1740–1806) who married, in 1761, Andrzej, comte Poniatowski (1735–1773), lieutenant-general in the Austrian service. He was elevated to prince in 1765. Her portrait by Lion is recorded, as are pastels by Marteau and Polish school.
