### PRESTEL, Johann Gottlieb

Grönenbach 18.XI.1739 – Frankfurt am Main 15.X.1808

Painter and engraver. At first a carpenter, he received his training in art from Zeiller; from Nogari, in Venice; and from Joseph Wagner. After a trip to Rome in 1767, he returned to Nürnberg and married Katharina Höll (q.n.). A portrait of her or (sometimes attributed to the sculptor Johann Georg Prestel) is thought to be by him, together with a profile. Both sheets, although described as pastels, seem to be more coloured chalk drawings.
