QUEULVÉE, Jean-Baptiste Évreux 1764 –1812

Queulvée, or Queullevée, was a deaf-mute. He was enrolled as an élève in the école de l'Académie royale on 15.I.1787 aged 19, as a pupil of David, living rue du Marche Palu. A 1791 self-portrait in oils (Paris, Christie's, 23.VI.2009, Lot 115 repr., as éc. fr.) was of notably higher quality than the surviving pastels.
