

QUEULVÉE, Jean-Baptiste

1764 – Évreux 1812

Queulvée, or Queullevée, was a deaf-mute. A 1791 self-portrait in oils (Paris, Christie's, 23.vi.2009, Lot 115 repr., as éc. fr.) was of notably higher quality than the surviving pastels.
