A pupil at the Académie royale in Paris, under the protection of the prince de Lorraine and of Boucher. A Ferdinand Quadal was admitted to the Royal Academy Schools in London on 6.XII.1773 ("aged 28"). There is no evidence that he worked in pastel before 1800.
