RABAUDY, Marie-Louis-Bernard de

Toulouse 1748–1791

Conseiller au parlement from 1767 (appointed at the age of scarcely 20 years) to 1790, appointed commissaire taxateur des dépens in 1789, attending the Toulouse assemblée de la noblesse in that year. He is probably the M. de Rabaudi, conseiller au parlement, collector and amateur artist, known from two submissions in 1767 at least one of which was in pastel. He lent a dozen or so religious, still life and genre pieces by various artists to the salons de Toulouse in 1777, 1786 and 1791.
