RAOUX, Jean

Montpellier 12.VI.1677 – Paris 10.II.1734

Raoux was a fashionable portraitist in oils, *agr  * 1715, *recu* in 1717; for Mariette, despite his careful handling, he drew badly and painted weakly, remaining always “un artiste assez m  diocre”. A few pastels attributed to him are more likely to be copies. Among his pupils, Jean Chevalier (*q.v.*) was a pastellist.
